- Very importantly providing a united forum enabling parent carers to not only have a voice, but for that voice to be heard, through parent carer participation whether directly in meetings or via feedback through surveys.

The PCC was formerly known as Parent Carer Council for Cornwall. It changed its name to differentiate that they work in coproduction with Cornwall Council but as an independent organisation.
